Cat and dog owners are asked to bring **proof of previous rabies vaccination** in order to receive a certificate valid for three years.

Ferret owners and pet owners without proof of vaccination will receive a certificate that is valid for one year.

All pets must be at least **3 months of age**.

Please keep animals on a **non-retractable leash** or in a **carrier**.
